ORDER OF SUSPENSION

10 WHEREAS, Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(B) requires the Administrative Director to
11 suspend any physician, practitioner, or provider from participating in the workers' compensation system
12 as a physician, practitioner, or provider who has been suspended, due to fraud or abuse, from the federal
13 Medicare or Medicaid programs; and

14 WHEREAS, Peter Anthony Beoris was suspended, due to fraud or abuse, from the federal
15 Medicare or Medicaid programs; and

16 WHEREAS, Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(C) requires the Administrative Director to
17 suspend any physician, practitioner, or provider from participating in the workers' compensation system
18 as a physician, practitioner, or provider whose license, certification or approval to provide health care
19 services has been surrendered or revoked; and

20 WHEREAS, on or about November 13, 2013, Peter Anthony Beoris' license, certification or
21 approval to provide health care services was surrendered or revoked by the Medical Board of California,
22 Department of Consumer Affairs; and

23 WHEREAS, on or about March 15, 2017, the Administrative Director mailed to Peter Anthony
24 Beoris a written notice of the right to a hearing regarding the suspension and the procedure to follow to
25 request a hearing, as provided in Labor Code section 139.21(b)(2) and California Code of Regulations,
26 title 8, section 9788.1; and

27 WHEREAS, pursuant to Labor Code section 139.21(b)(2) and California Code of Regulations,
28 title 8, section 9788.1(d), the written notice advised Peter Anthony Beoris that the suspension would
start thirty (30) calendar days after the date of mailing of written notice, unless Peter Anthony Beoris


1 submitted a written request for a hearing within ten (10) calendar days of the date of mailing of the
2 notice; and

3 WHEREAS, Peter Anthony Beoris did not submit a written request for hearing within ten (10)
4 calendar days of the date of mailing of the notice; and

5 WHEREAS, the Administrative Director is required to suspend any physician, practitioner, or
6 provider pursuant to Labor Code section 139.21 and Title 8, California Code of Regulations section
7 9788.2, after thirty (30) days from the date the notice was mailed, unless the physician, practitioner, or
8 provider submits a written request for a hearing within ten (10) calendar days of the date of mailing of
9 the notice;

10 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that Peter Anthony Beoris is hereby suspended from participating
11 in the workers' compensation system as a physician, practitioner, or provider.
