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11 ORDER OF SUSPENSION

12 WHEREAS, Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(C) requires the Administrative Director  
13 to suspend any physician, practitioner, or provider from participating in the workers'  
14 compensation system as a physician, practitioner, or provider whose license, certification,  
15 or approval to provide health care services has been surrendered or revoked; and

16 WHEREAS, on or about February 8, 2023, Respondent Cara L. Haverstock's  
17 license, certification, or approval to provide health care services was surrendered or  
18 revoked by the Board of Pharmacy, Department of Consumer Affairs; and

19 WHEREAS, on or about January 9, 2024, the Administrative Director mailed to Cara  
20 L. Haverstock a written notice of the right to a hearing regarding the suspension and the  
21 procedure to follow to request a hearing, as provided in Labor Code section 139.21(b)(2)  
22 and California Code of Regulations, title 8, section 9788.1; and

23 WHEREAS, pursuant to Labor Code section 139.21(b)(2) and California Code of  
24 Regulations, title 8, section 9788.1(d), the written notice advised Cara L. Haverstock that  
25 the suspension would start thirty (30) calendar days after the date of mailing of written  
26 notice, unless Cara L. Haverstock submitted a written request for a hearing within ten (10)  
27 calendar days of the date of mailing of the notice; and

28 WHEREAS, Cara L. Haverstock did not submit a written request for hearing within  
ten (10) calendar days of the date of mailing of the notice; and

1           WHEREAS, the Administrative Director is required to suspend any physician,  
2 practitioner, or provider pursuant to Labor Code section 139.21 and California Code of  
3 Regulations, title 8, section 9788.2, after thirty (30) days from the date the notice was  
4 mailed, unless the physician, practitioner, or provider submits a written request for a  
5 hearing within ten (10) calendar days of the date of mail of the notice;

6           **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that Respondent Cara L. Haverstock is hereby  
7 suspended from participating in the workers' compensation system as a physician,  
8 practitioner, or provider.
