ORDER OF SUSPENSION

10 WHEREAS, Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(A) requires the Administrative Director to
11 suspend any physician, practitioner, or provider from participating in the workers' compensation system
12 as a physician, practitioner, or provider if the individual has been convicted of any felony or
13 misdemeanor described in Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(A); and

14 WHEREAS, on or about June 23, 2017, Joseph Everett Long pled guilty to or was found guilty
15 of one or more felonies or misdemeanors described in Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(A) in the
16 Superior Court of California, County of San Francisco; and

17 WHEREAS, Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(C) requires the Administrative Director to
18 suspend any physician, practitioner, or provider from participating in the workers' compensation system
19 as a physician, practitioner, or provider whose license, certification or approval to provide health care
20 services has been surrendered or revoked; and

21 WHEREAS, on or about March 7, 2017, Joseph Everett Long's license, certification or approval
22 to provide health care services was surrendered or revoked by the Medical Board of California,
23 Department of Consumer Affairs; and

24 WHEREAS, on or about January 24, 2019, the Administrative Director mailed to Joseph Everett
25 Long a written notice of the right to a hearing regarding the suspension and the procedure to follow to
26 request a hearing, as provided in Labor Code section 139.21(b)(2) and California Code of Regulations,
27 title 8, section 9788.1; and

28 WHEREAS, pursuant to Labor Code section 139.21(b)(2) and California Code of Regulations,
title 8, section 9788.1(d), the written notice advised Joseph Everett Long that the suspension would start


1 thirty (30) calendar days after the date of mailing of written notice, unless Joseph Everett Long
2 submitted a written request for a hearing within ten (10) calendar days of the date of mailing of the
3 notice; and

4 WHEREAS, Joseph Everett Long did not submit a written request for hearing within ten (10)
5 calendar days of the date of mailing of the notice; and

6 WHEREAS, the Administrative Director is required to suspend any physician, practitioner, or
7 provider pursuant to Labor Code section 139.21 and title 8, California Code of Regulations section
8 9788.2, after thirty (30) days from the date the notice was mailed, unless the physician, practitioner, or
9 provider submits a written request for a hearing within ten (10) calendar days of the date of mailing of
10 the notice;

11 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that Joseph Everett Long is hereby suspended from participating
12 in the workers' compensation system as a physician, practitioner, or provider.
