ORDER OF SUSPENSION

9 WHEREAS, Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(C) requires the Administrative Director to
10 suspend any physician, practitioner, or provider from participating in the worker's compensation
11 system as a physician, practitioner, or provider whose license, certification or approval to
12 provide health care services has been surrendered or revoked; and

13 WHEREAS, on or about March 24, 2017, Thomas Murnane's license, certification or
14 approval to provide health care services was surrendered or revoked by the Medical Board of
15 California, Department of Consumer Affairs; and

16 WHEREAS, on or about April 20, 2018, the Administrative Director mailed to Thomas
17 Murnane a written notice of right to a hearing regarding the suspension and the procedure to
18 follow to request a hearing, as provided in Labor Code section 139.21(b)(2) and California Code
19 of Regulations, title 8, section 9788.1; and

20 WHEREAS, pursuant to Labor Code section 139.21(b)(2) and California Code of
21 Regulations, title 8, section 9788.1(d) the written notice advised Thomas Murnane that the
22 suspension would start thirty (30) calendar days after the date of mailing of written notice, unless
23 Thomas Murnane submitted a written request for a hearing within ten (10) calendar days of the
24 date of mailing of the notice; and

25 WHEREAS, Thomas Murnane did not submit a written request for hearing within ten (10)
26 calendar days of the date of mailing of the notice; and

27 WHEREAS, the Administrative Director is required to suspend any physician, practitioner,
28 or provider pursuant to Labor Code section 139.21 and Title 8, California Code of Regulations
section 9788.2, after thirty (30) days from the date of notice was mailed, unless the physician,
practitioner, or provider submits a written request for a hearing within ten (10) calendar days of
the date of mailing of the notice;

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IT IS HEREBY ORDERED Thomas Murnane is hereby suspended from participating in the workers' compensation system as a physician, practitioner, or provider.
