ORDER OF SUSPENSION

9 WHEREAS, Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(A) requires the Administrative Director to
10 suspend any physician, practitioner, or provider from participating in the workers' compensation
11 system as a physician, practitioner, or provider if the individual has been convicted of any felony
12 or misdemeanor described in Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(A); and

13 WHEREAS, on or about October 2, 2017, Knarik Vardumyan pled guilty to or was found
14 guilty of one or more felonies or misdemeanors described in Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(A)
in United States District Court, Central District of California; and

15 WHEREAS, on or about April 20, 2018, the Administrative Director mailed to Knarik
16 Vardumyan a written notice of the right to a hearing regarding the suspension and the procedure
17 to follow to request a hearing, as provided in Labor Code section 139.21(b)(2) and California
18 Code of Regulations, title 8, section 9788.1; and

19 WHEREAS, pursuant to Labor Code section 139.21(b)(2) and California Code of
20 Regulations, title 8, section 9788.1(d) the written notice advised Knarik Vardumyan that the
21 suspension would start thirty (30) calendar days after the date of mailing of written notice, unless
22 Knarik Vardumyan submitted a written request for a hearing within ten (10) calendar days of the
date of mailing of the notice; and


23 WHEREAS, Knarik Vardumyan did not submit a written request for hearing within ten
24 (10) calendar days of the date of mailing of the notice; and

25 WHEREAS, the Administrative Director is required to suspend any physician, practitioner,
26 or provider pursuant to Labor Code section 139.21 and Title 8, California Code of Regulations
27 section 9788.2, after thirty (30) days from the date of notice was mailed, unless the physician,
28 practitioner, or provider submits a written request for a hearing within ten (10) calendar days of
the date of mailing of the notice;

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IT IS HEREBY ORDERED Knarik Vardumyan is hereby suspended from participating in the workers' compensation system as a physician, practitioner, or provider.
