I appreciate you sending me the notice of suspension letter and clarifying the purpose of this notice is limited to whether or not Labor code section 139.21 (a) (1) is applicable to me. Based on the labor code that I have imbedded in this document below. The code is explicit to physicians, practitioners or providers.....

139.21.


(a) (1) The administrative director shall promptly suspend, pursuant to subdivision (b), any physician, practitioner, or provider from participating in the workers' compensation system as a physician, practitioner, or provider if the individual or entity meets any of the following criteria:

I want to make it clear that I am not and have never been a physician, practitioner or provider of the workers compensation system.

I believe the confusion may be due to the initial court filing implying that I was a pharmacist, which I have never been.

Let me also clarify that all but one charge was dropped. In order to diminish the stress and undo financial strain this case was causing my family I agreed to accept a plea for a misdemeanor.

Per your notice, I am submitting this written request for a hearing to clarify why Labor Code section 139.21 (a) (1) does not apply to me. As requested, the required information is below:
