PREDETERMINED INCREASE FOR
IRON WORKER (C-20-X-1-2011-2)
IRON WORK (ORNAMENTAL, REINFORCING, STRUCTURAL)
FENCE ERECTOR
IN ALL STATEWIDE LOCALITIES

This predetermined increase for the above named craft applies only to the above referenced determination for work being performed on public works projects with bid advertisement dates on or after **September 1, 2011**, until this determination is superseded by a new determination or a predetermined increase modification notice becomes effective.

When referencing our prevailing wage determinations, please note that if the prevailing wage rate determination which was in effect on the bid advertisement date of a project has a single asterisk (*) after the expiration date, the rate will be good for the life of the project. However, if a prevailing wage rate determination has double asterisks (**) after the expiration date, the rate must be updated on the following date to reflect the predetermined rate change(s).

IRON WORKER (ORNAMENTAL, REINFORCING, STRUCTURAL)

Determination C-20-X-1-2011-2 is in effect and expires on June 30, 2012**.

Effective July 1, 2012, the increase of \$0.55 was allocated as follows: \$0.20 to Health & Welfare and \$0.35 to Pension. In addition, \$0.09 of Other (IMPACT Fund) was reallocated to Health and Welfare.

Effective January 1, 2013, there was an increase of \$0.55 to Health and Welfare.

Effective July 1, 2013, there will be an increase of \$1.00 to Pension.

Effective January 1, 2014, there will be an increase of \$1.00 to be allocated as follows: \$0.50 to Basic Hourly Rate, \$0.15 to Health & Welfare, and \$0.35 to Pension.

FENCE ERECTOR

Determination C-20-X-1-2011-2 is in effect and expires on June 30, 2012**.

Effective July 1, 2012, the increase of \$0.55 was allocated as follows: \$0.20 to Health & Welfare and \$0.35 to Pension.

Effective January 1, 2013, there was an increase of \$0.55 to Health and Welfare.

Effective July 1, 2013, there will be an increase of \$1.00 to Pension.

Effective January 1, 2014, there will be an increase of \$1.00 to be allocated as follows: \$0.50 to Basic Hourly Rate, \$0.15 to Health & Welfare, and \$0.35 to Pension.

There will be no further increases applicable to this determination.
