



PREDETERMINED INCREASE FOR
IRON WORKER (C-20-X-1-2014-2)
IRON WORKER (ORNAMENTAL, REINFORCING, STRUCTURAL)
FENCE ERECTOR

IN ALL STATEWIDE LOCALITIES

This predetermined increase for the above named craft applies only to the above referenced determination for work being performed on public works projects with bid advertisement dates on or after **September 1, 2014** until this determination is superseded by a new determination or a predetermined increase modification notice becomes effective.

When referencing our prevailing wage determinations, please note that if the prevailing wage rate determination which was in effect on the bid advertisement date of a project has a single asterisk (*) after the expiration date, the rate will be good for the life of the project. However, if a prevailing wage rate determination has double asterisks (**) after the expiration date, the rate must be updated on the following date to reflect the predetermined rate change(s).

IRON WORKER (ALL CLASSIFICATIONS)

Determination C-20-X-1-2014-2 is in effect and expires on December 31, 2014**.

Effective January 1, 2015, there will be an increase of \$.60 to be allocated: \$.55 to Health and Welfare, and \$.05 to Other Payments.

Effective July 1, 2015, there will be an increase of \$.66 to be allocated: \$.65 to Pension and \$.01 to Other Payments. (See Important Notice issued June 17, 2015)

Effective January 1, 2016, there will be an increase of \$.85 to be allocated: \$.50 to Basic Hourly Rate and \$.35 to Pension.

Effective July 1, 2016, there will be an increase of \$.75 to be allocated: \$.75 to Basic Hourly Rate.

Effective January 1, 2017, there will be an increase of \$1.90 to be allocated: \$1.25 to the Basic Hourly Rate, \$.13 to Health and Welfare, \$.08 to Vacation and \$.44 to Others.

FENCE ERECTOR

Determination C-20-X-1-2014-2 is in effect and expires on December 31, 2014**.

Effective January 1, 2015, there will be an increase of \$.60 to be allocated: \$.55 to Health and Welfare, and \$.05 to Other Payments.

Effective July 1, 2015, there will be an increase of \$.65 to be allocated as follows: \$.65 to Pension. (See Important Notice issued June 17, 2015)

Effective January 1, 2016, there will be an increase of \$.85 to be allocated: \$.50 to Basic Hourly Rate and \$.35 to Pension.

Effective July 1, 2016, there will be an increase of \$.75 to be allocated: \$.75 to Basic Hourly Rate.

Effective January 1, 2017, there will be an increase of \$1.85 to be allocated: \$1.25 to the Basic Hourly Rate, \$.13 to Health and Welfare, \$.08 to Vacation and \$.39 to Others (See Important Notice issued January 6, 2017).

There will be no further increases applicable to this determination.
