This predetermined increase for the above named craft applies only to the current determination for work being performed on public works projects with bid advertisement dates on or after March 4, 2015, until this determination is superseded by a new determination or a predetermined increase modification notice becomes effective.

When referencing our prevailing wage determinations, please note that if the prevailing wage rate determination which was in effect on the bid advertisement date of a project has a single asterisk (*) after the expiration date, the rate will be good for the life of the project. However, if a prevailing wage rate determination has double asterisks (**) after the expiration date, the rate must be updated on the following date to reflect the predetermined rate change(s).

TREE TRIMMER: 1st year Climber

Determination C-TT-61-465-5A-2015-1 is currently in effect and expires on December 26, 2015**.

Effective December 27, 2015, there will be an increase of \$0.46 to the Basic Hourly Rate and \$0.03 to Vacation & Holiday.

TREE TRIMMER: 2nd year Climber

Determination C-TT-61-465-5A-2015-1 is currently in effect and expires on December 26, 2015**.

Effective December 27, 2015, there will be an increase of \$0.55 to the Basic Hourly Rate and \$0.05 to Vacation & Holiday.

TREE TRIMMER: 3rd year Climber

Determination C-TT-61-465-5A-2015-1 is currently in effect and expires on December 26, 2015**.

Effective December 27, 2015, there will be an increase of \$0.60 to the Basic Hourly Rate and \$0.05 to Vacation & Holiday.

TREE TRIMMER: Thereafter Climber

Determination C-TT-61-465-5A-2015-1 is currently in effect and expires on December 26, 2015**.

Effective December 27, 2015, there will be an increase of \$0.62 to the Basic Hourly Rate and \$0.05 to Vacation & Holiday (Climber after 10 years of service at this level there will be an increase of \$0.62 to the Basic Hourly Rate and \$0.06 to Vacation & Holiday.).

TRIMMER TRAINEE: Step 1 (0 – 6 MONTHS)

Determination C-TT-61-465-5A-2015-1 is currently in effect and expires on December 26, 2015**.

Effective December 27, 2015, there will be an increase of \$0.38 to the Basic Hourly Rate and \$0.02 to Vacation & Holiday.

TRIMMER TRAINEE: Step 2 (7 – 18 MONTHS)

Determination C-TT-61-465-5A-2015-1 is currently in effect and expires on December 26, 2015**.

Effective December 27, 2015, there will be an increase of \$0.40 to the Basic Hourly Rate and \$0.01 to Vacation & Holiday (Trimmer Trainee after 1 year of service at this level there will be an increase of \$0.40 to the Basic Hourly Rate and \$0.03 to Vacation & Holiday).

GROUNDMAN

Determination C-TT-61-465-5A-2015-1 is currently in effect and expires on December 26, 2015**.

Effective December 27, 2015, there will be an increase of \$0.35 to the Basic Hourly Rate and \$0.02 to Vacation & Holiday (Groundman after 1 year of service at this level there will be an increase of \$0.35 to the Basic Hourly Rate and \$0.02 to Vacation & Holiday; Groundperson after 2 years of service at this level there will be an increase of \$0.35 to the Basic Hourly Rate and \$0.03 to Vacation & Holiday; Groundperson after 10 years of service at this level there will be an increase of \$0.35 to the Basic Hourly Rate and \$0.03 to Vacation & Holiday).

There will be no further increases applicable to this determination.
