**TERRAZZO
AGREEMENT**

Between

CORRADINI CORP

and the

SOUTHWEST REGIONAL COUNCIL OF CARPENTERS

JUNE 1, 2015 TO MAY 31, 2018

Section 3. Employees will receive their regular hourly rate for any time consumed in traveling between multiple jobs in the same day plus mileage, said mileage will be paid at \$0.20 per mile. The stipulated rate will be paid on all traveling time.

Section 4. TRAVEL: FROM LOS ANGELES CITY HALL BASED ON THOMAS BROTHERS MAP (as the "crow flies" per the radius map).

(a) All Employees are entitled to receive the following subsistence pay when performing work in the designated travel zones:

- (i) 71 -150 miles - \$70.00 per day, for every day worked
- (ii) over 150 miles - \$80.00 per work day, \$80.00 per day for non-workdays, such as weekends and holidays.
- (iii) San Francisco Bay Area - \$95.00 day worked; \$70.00 on weekends and holidays.
- (iv) San Diego City - \$80.00 per day worked.
- (v) Hawaii - \$90.00 per work day, \$90.00 per day for non-workdays, such as weekends and holidays.
- (vi) Work that is over 1,000 miles from Los Angeles, add \$5.00 per day to subsistence.

(b) On out of town projects the Contractor may hire workman in that locality for such project and no subsistence shall be required. This may include workman never employed by the Contractor previously who travel to the locality to seek work. However, this provision shall not be utilized to deny subsistence to any current or former employee of the Contractor who works in a designated travel zone.

Section 5. Contractor agrees to provide three (3) day's notice to each employee for out of town work, except in case of emergency.

Section 6. (a) When an employee is required to report to the shop and use his car for transportation to a jobsite he will receive \$0.20 per mile per road mile. If the employee is required to haul equipment or materials the employee will receive \$0.40 per road mile.

(b) When the jobs are located in remote or resort places where additional expense may be encountered the expense allowance shall be increased to cover the additional expense.

Section 7. All traveling time plus subsistence shall be paid by the employer on out-of-town jobs over 150 miles and the time spent in traveling shall be paid at the regular wage rate.

Section 8. Terrazzo Workers will not be required to drive more than twelve hours in a day to travel to a job, as an individual.
