**ARTICLE XVI
HOLIDAYS**

Holidays recognized by this Agreement shall be: New Year's Day, Martin Luther King Jr. Day, Presidents Day, Good Friday, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Veterans Day, Thanksgiving and Christmas.

When a recognized holiday falls on Tuesday, the previous Monday shall be considered a holiday. When a recognized holiday falls on Thursday, the Friday immediately following shall be considered a holiday. When a recognized holiday falls on a Saturday, the previous Friday shall be considered a holiday. When a recognized holiday falls on Sunday, the following Monday shall be considered a holiday. No work shall be required on Labor Day except in cases of extreme emergency.
