

Dear Mr. Wilson:

On 5/19/2014 the Division of Occupational Safety & Health notified the Appeals Board that it had referred your case to its Bureau of Investigations. Unless you submit a written request asking that your appeal of this case go forward in the normal course, we will delay the processing of your appeal case until conclusion of the review by the Bureau of Investigations (BOI), **OR for a period of three years from the first day of the inspection – whichever occurs earlier.** (See: Board Regulation 376(c))

If the case is held in abeyance pending the outcome of BOI, any and all motions filed by the parties will be held and not ruled upon until either BOI closes its investigation or the three year period has expired.
