EXECUTIVE OFFICER'S REPORT:

1. NEW PROCESSES PROJECT:

ACTION; Executive Officer Johnson reported on the project to develop a replacement for the ORACLE software used to track and calendar appeals. A small committee has nearly finished creating flow charts and descriptions of each process, which will be used to build a list of requirements for the new system.

2. VISIT TO WEST COVINA

ACTION: EO Johnson visited the West Covina office last week. She is working with the West Covina staff to help them realign their work flow in the wake of the retirement of Marjorie Cordova, Senior Legal Typist. Marjorie spent 32 years in state service, and was with the Board since 1990.

EO Johnson also reported that bids will be taken to install a new telephone panel in the West Covina office. An order has already been placed for a new VOIP telephone system in the office. In addition, plans for the projected office remodel have been modified and the project to increase

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security and efficiency will be starting up in 2014. The West Covina staff is also doing some housekeeping projects around the office, including general cleanup and packing its old computers to send to other agencies.
