1 **STATE OF CALIFORNIA** DEPARTMENT OF INDUSTRIAL RELATIONS 2 **DIVISION OF WORKERS' COMPENSATION** 3 BEFORE THE ADMINISTRATIVE DIRECTOR 4 5 In Re: PROVIDER SUSPENSION 6 JAVAD AGHALOO, **ORDER OF SUSPENSION** 7 8 Respondent. 9 10 11 12 WHEREAS, Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(A) requires the Administrative Director 13 to suspend any physician, practitioner, or provider from participating in the workers' 14 compensation system as a physician, practitioner, or provider if the individual has been 15 convicted of any felony or misdemeanor described in Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(A): 16 and 17 WHEREAS, on or about February 12, 2024, Respondent Javad Aghaloo pled guilty 18 to or was found guilty of one or more felonies or misdemeanors described in Labor Code 19 section 139.21(a)(1)(A) in the United States District Court, Southern District of California; 20 and 21 WHEREAS, Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(B) requires the Administrative Director 22 to suspend any physician, practitioner, or provider from participating in the workers' 23 compensation system as a physician, practitioner, or provider who has been suspended, 24 due to fraud or abuse, from the federal Medicare or Medicaid programs; and 25 WHEREAS, Javad Aghaloo was suspended, due to fraud or abuse, from the federal 26 Medicare or Medicaid programs; and 27 WHEREAS, on or about October 8, 2024, the Administrative Director mailed to 28 Javad Aghaloo a written notice of the right to a hearing regarding the suspension and the

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procedure to follow to request a hearing, as provided in Labor Code section 139.21(b)(2) and California Code of Regulations, title 8, section 9788.1; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Labor Code section 139.21(b)(2) and California Code of Regulations, title 8, section 9788.1(d), the written notice advised Javad Aghaloo that the suspension would start thirty (30) calendar days after the date of mailing of written notice, unless Javad Aghaloo submitted a written request for a hearing within ten (10) calendar days of the date of mailing of the notice; and

WHEREAS, Javad Aghaloo did not submit a written request for hearing within ten (10) calendar days of the date of mailing of the notice; and

WHEREAS, the Administrative Director is required to suspend any physician, practitioner, or provider pursuant to Labor Code section 139.21 and California Code of Regulations, title 8, section 9788.2, after thirty (30) days from the date the notice was mailed, unless the physician, practitioner, or provider submits a written request for a hearing within ten (10) calendar days of the date of mail of the notice;

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that Respondent Javad Aghaloo is hereby suspended from participating in the workers' compensation system as a physician, practitioner, or provider.
