ORDER OF SUSPENSION

WHEREAS, Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(C) requires the Administrative Director to suspend any physician, practitioner, or provider from participating in the workers' compensation system as a physician, practitioner, or provider whose license, certification, or approval to provide health care services has been surrendered or revoked; and

WHEREAS, on or about February 2, 2023, Respondent Nancy Herrmann-Hart's, aka Nancy Lynn Hart, aka Nancy Hart (Nancy Hermann-Hart), license, certification, or approval to provide health care services was surrendered or revoked by the Board of Registered Nursing, Department of Consumer Affairs; and

WHEREAS, on or about September 11, 2024, the Administrative Director mailed to Nancy Herrmann-Hart a written notice of the right to a hearing regarding the suspension and the procedure to follow to request a hearing, as provided in Labor Code section 139.21(b)(2) and California Code of Regulations, title 8, section 9788.1; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Labor Code section 139.21(b)(2) and California Code of Regulations, title 8, section 9788.1(d), the written notice advised Nancy Herrmann-Hart that the suspension would start thirty (30) calendar days after the date of mailing of written notice, unless Nancy Herrmann-Hart submitted a written request for a hearing within ten (10) calendar days of the date of mailing of the notice; and

WHEREAS, Nancy Herrmann-Hart did not submit a written request for hearing within ten (10) calendar days of the date of mailing of the notice; and

WHEREAS, the Administrative Director is required to suspend any physician, practitioner, or provider pursuant to Labor Code section 139.21 and California Code of Regulations, title 8, section 9788.2, after thirty (30) days from the date the notice was mailed, unless the physician, practitioner, or provider submits a written request for a hearing within ten (10) calendar days of the date of mail of the notice;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Respondent Nancy Herrmann-Hart is hereby suspended from participating in the workers' compensation system as a physician, practitioner, or provider.
