ORDER OF SUSPENSION

WHEREAS, Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(A) requires the Administrative Director to suspend any physician, practitioner, or provider from participating in the workers' compensation system as a physician, practitioner, or provider if the individual has been convicted of any felony or misdemeanor described in Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(A); and

WHEREAS, on or about November 9, 2022, Respondent Joseph Andrew Mollick (Joseph Mollick) pled guilty to or was found guilty of one or more felonies or misdemeanors described in Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(A) in the United States District Court, Northern District of California; and

WHEREAS, Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(B) requires the Administrative Director to suspend any physician, practitioner, or provider from participating in the workers' compensation system as a physician, practitioner, or provider who has been suspended, due to fraud or abuse, from the federal Medicare or Medicaid programs; and

WHEREAS, Joseph Mollick was suspended, due to fraud or abuse, from the federal Medicare or Medicaid programs; and

WHEREAS, Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(C) requires the Administrative Director to suspend any physician, practitioner, or provider from participating in the workers'

1 compensation system as a physician, practitioner, or provider whose license, certification,
2 or approval to provide health care services has been surrendered or revoked; and

3 WHEREAS, on or about July 30, 2023, Joseph Mollick's license, certification, or
4 approval to provide health care services was surrendered or revoked by the California
5 Medical Board, Department of Consumer Affairs; and

6 WHEREAS, on or about October 8, 2024, the Administrative Director mailed to
7 Joseph Mollick a written notice of the right to a hearing regarding the suspension and the
8 procedure to follow to request a hearing, as provided in Labor Code section 139.21(b)(2)
9 and California Code of Regulations, title 8, section 9788.1; and

10 WHEREAS, pursuant to Labor Code section 139.21(b)(2) and California Code of
11 Regulations, title 8, section 9788.1(d), the written notice advised Joseph Mollick that the
12 suspension would start thirty (30) calendar days after the date of mailing of written notice,
13 unless Joseph Mollick submitted a written request for a hearing within ten (10) calendar
14 days of the date of mailing of the notice; and

15 WHEREAS, Joseph Mollick did not submit a written request for hearing within ten
16 (10) calendar days of the date of mailing of the notice; and

17 WHEREAS, the Administrative Director is required to suspend any physician,
18 practitioner, or provider pursuant to Labor Code section 139.21 and California Code of
19 Regulations, title 8, section 9788.2, after thirty (30) days from the date the notice was
20 mailed, unless the physician, practitioner, or provider submits a written request for a
21 hearing within ten (10) calendar days of the date of mail of the notice;

22 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that Respondent Joseph Mollick is hereby suspended
23 from participating in the workers' compensation system as a physician, practitioner, or
24 provider.
