HOLIDAYS

Section 3. Holidays.

(a) The following are nationally recognized holidays covered by this Agreement: New Year's Day, Martin Luther King, Jr. Day, Presidents' Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, the Friday following Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day. If any of the above holidays fall on Saturday, the preceding Friday shall be observed as the holiday. If any of the above holidays fall on Sunday, the Monday following shall be observed as the holiday.

(b) Four (4) days of each calendar year will be selected by the Union as designated days off. All signatory Employers will be notified at the beginning of each calendar year regarding holidays and designated days off.

(c) The following designated days off will be observed.

2025: Friday, February 14th, Friday, May 23th, Friday, August 29th, Friday, December 26th.

2026: Friday, January 2th, Friday, February 13th, Friday, May 22th, Friday, September 4nd

2027: Friday, January 15th, Friday, May 28th, Friday, September 3rd, Friday, November 12th

2028: Friday, January 14, Friday, February 18th, Friday, May 26th, Friday, September 1st

2029: Friday, January 12th, Friday, February 16th, Friday, May 25th, Friday, August 31st

The four designated off/collectively bargained holidays shall be governed by Article 10, Section 2. Overtime.
