**IMPORTANT NOTICE TO AWARDING BODIES AND ALL INTERESTED PARTIES
REGARDING A CORRECTION TO
THE DIRECTOR'S GENERAL PREVAILING WAGE DETERMINATIONS**

Dear Public Official/Other Interested Parties:

CRAFT/CLASSIFICATION: Laborer and Related Classifications

LOCALITIES: All localities within Alameda, Alpine, Amador, Butte, Calaveras, Colusa, Contra Costa, Del Norte, El Dorado, Fresno, Glenn, Humboldt, Kings, Lake, Lassen, Madera, Mariposa, Marin, Mendocino, Merced, Modoc, Monterey, Napa, Nevada, Placer, Plumas, Sacramento, San Benito, San Francisco, San Joaquin, San Mateo, Santa Clara, Santa Cruz, Shasta, Sierra, Siskiyou, Solano, Sonoma, Stanislaus, Sutter, Tehama, Trinity, Tulare, Tuolumne, Yolo, and Yuba Counties.

DETERMINATION: NC-23-102-1-2026-1

Page two, paragraph two, of the travel and subsistence provisions for the above mentioned determination contains a typographical error. The correct language is as follows:

“Any employee operating or responsible for the control of a company vehicle being used to transport personnel, equipment and/or supplies from the employer's regularly established shop or yard to a jobsite shall be compensated at a rate of **twenty-one dollars and ninety-seven cents** (\$21.97) per hour. Any employee who is a passenger in and not directly responsible for the control of a company vehicle is deemed to be in the vehicle voluntarily and is not subject to compensation other than discussed above. Employees assigned company vehicles will not be compensated for travel to and from the project to their homes unless it is in excess of sixty (60) miles from the regularly established shop or yard.”

With the exception of the above correction, all of the wage rates and other conditions found in the above-referenced prevailing wage determination remain unchanged.
