#### **Updates:**

In the 2nd quarter, DAS continues to make progress on hiring and also optimizing the registration process and also how DAS supports all program types, including Pre-Apprenticeship. The Apprenticeship and Workforce Innovation Team is now being lead by Paul Giacomotto, who was promoted into the role effective June 18th, and brings with him a depth of experience supporting the development of key apprenticeship programs such as those in the semiconductor advanced manufacturing space and also hiring, training and supporting AWI team members. Paul will be a key point of contact for the IACA community.

In 2018, the program type of Pre-Apprenticeship was established in Labor Code 3100, and since then, the number of Apprenticeship programs registered with DAS has been steadily increasing, now with 186 pre-apprenticeship programs registered. Initially Pre-Apprenticeships were being registered and supported by one person in the Program Planning and Review (PPR) team, and this team has been increasingly overloaded with new program registrations and standards revisions, as shared in previous meetings. DAS has therefore, over the past 6 months, shifted the support of Pre-Apprenticeship programs away from PPR, and over to the Program teams including the Apprenticeship and Workforce Innovation team, and in particular the Youth and Pre-Apprenticeship team. Therefore, if you are a stakeholder with a Pre-Apprenticeship program, you should now be going directly to your assigned DAS Apprenticeship Consultant/Advisor for program and pre-apprentice registration and any troubleshooting related to Pre-Apprenticeship Program. We hope that this shift both better supports the Pre-Apprenticeship programs and also optimizes the workload to ease the bottleneck for PPR, allowing them the focus on program registrations and revisions.

DAS is continuing its prioritized focus on the registration of new apprenticeship programs, and we are happy to share that there were 11 new programs approved in the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter spanning a variety of areas from a Search Marketing Strategist with the State Center Apprenticeship Hub to Perioperative Registered Nurse with Bakersfield College to CNC Operator with Rise Up Industries. DAS hopes to continue this progress in registering new programs.

In the recently finalized budget, DAS has not been allocated any additional funding specifically focused on IACA Apprenticeship, however DAS is still administering the funding allocated in previous budget cycles for the Apprenticeship Innovation Funding and the CA Opportunity Youth Apprenticeship – see further updates in the Funding section below. On the CAC side, DAS was allocated an additional \$14.9M for the Women in Construction Priority Program and there was an adjustment to the CAC Training Funds to better balance the inflows and outflows of that fund, increasing the annual grants from \$3M to \$20M annually.

DAS is looking forward to the upcoming <u>Advancing CA Apprenticeship Summit</u> taking place October 7-9 in Riverside, CA and we hope to get to see many of you at the event. Both to encourage participation and seize the opportunity to gather in person, the IACA Q4 Meeting will be taking place adjacent to and co-located with the Summit on Thursday October 9<sup>th</sup>.

#### **Funding Information**

In Q2, DAS closed the applications for the third round of Apprenticeship Innovation Funding (AIF) to reimburse program sponsors and LEAs for supporting and training eligible IACA apprentices in 2024. Applications were accepted from February 18 through April 17, 2025. They are now being processed on a rolling basis for eligibility review, corrections (if needed), and award determination. As of the deadline, DAS has received 82 applications requesting a total of \$33,386,357.21. Confirmation emails acknowledging receipt have been sent to all applicants, and the first batch of award letters and payments initiated in Q2. The DAS Funding Team is currently reviewing applications and will communicate directly with awardees regarding next steps.

Also in Q2, the deadline for the 2<sup>nd</sup> round of the CA Opportunity Youth Apprenticeship (COYA) Grant closed on April 10, 2025. DAS received 142 proposals requesting a total of \$87 million in funding. The breakdown of proposals was:

- 100 Apprenticeship Planning proposals totaling \$46 million,
- 24 Pre-Apprenticeship Implementation proposals totaling \$25 million
- 18 Apprenticeship Implementation proposals totaling \$15.2 million.

In June, the 2nd Round of the COYA Grant awardees were announced by Governor Newsom, announcing the intent to fund over \$15 million in awards to 29 youth apprenticeship and preapprenticeship programs across many industries from the fire trades to union entertainment jobs, and education paraprofessional roles. COYA Round 2 Highlights:

- Total Funding Awarded: \$15,428,999 29 Grantees
- Apprenticeship Planning Grant (COYA-AP): \$7,192,091 18 Grantees
- Pre-Apprenticeship Implementation Grant (COYA-PI): \$3,088,000 4 Grantees
- Apprenticeship Implementation Grant (COYA-AI): \$5,148,908 7 Grantees

#### Statistics of June 30 2025, this Committee / California total

The active apprentices numbered 21,448/91,318

New registrations and reinstatements numbered 2,511/9,532 for the quarter.

Minorities represented 78.7% / 72.9% of all active apprentices.

Active women apprentices numbered 6,337/8,825, which is 29.6% / 9.66% of all active apprentices.

There are currently 1,214/4,337 active veterans, 182/408 which registered, and 165/281 completed in 2025.

#### Program Evaluations April 1 2025, through June 30, 2025

Since April 1, 2025, DAS opened six (6) program evaluations, and seven (7) evaluations have been completed. Ten (10) program evaluations are in progress and there are twenty-four (24) programs with corrective action needed (six (6) opened in 2022, four (4) opened in 2023, five (5) opened in 2024, and nine (9) opened in 2025). DAS consultants are monitoring these programs to ensure their recommendations are completed.

DAS will continue to send new evaluation notification letters one year following the creation of a new program or substantial expansion of an existing program. To ensure high-quality apprenticeship administration, consultants will assist apprenticeship programs with correcting the deficiencies found in order to close their evaluations/reviews.
