#### **Updates:**

The 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter kicked off with the announcement of the awardees of the 2<sup>nd</sup> round of the CA Opportunity Youth Apprenticeship (COYA) Grant program, announcing \$15.4 million in grants to 29 different programs connecting opportunity youth to apprenticeship pathways. And this was further recognized and celebrated with First Partner Jennifer Siebel Newsom visiting a COYA Grantee, the Handy Foundation, where both the apprentices, the employers and union partners all shared the impact of the apprenticeship program on both apprentices and the industry. In early August the 2<sup>nd</sup> round of awardees was also announced for the Equal Representation in Construction Apprenticeships (ERiCA) Grant, awarding \$26.2 million in funding to 25 different entities working to improve representation in the building trades. Both cohorts of grantees have finalized all contracts and kicked of activities under the grant.

DAS is very excited to support and participate in the first ever Advancing CA Apprenticeship Summit, and hosting the IACA meeting adjacent to that event. DAS applauds and appreciates the Irvine Foundation for their support of the event and also appreciates all the organizers including the Foundation for CA Community Colleges and LAUNCH for all the hard work in convening and organizing the event.

DAS remains laser focused on streamlining the new program and occupation registration process and continues to make progress with 7 more new programs registered in Q3. The new programs registered span many industries from advanced manufacturing with FM Industries with an Industrial Manufacturing Technician and Electromechanical Technician, to healthcare with both SLO Partners and Butte County Regional Occupational Program with Dental Assistant occupations, and business services with the Risk Management's Career Pathway to Apprenticeship with a Workers Compensation Analyst occupation.

DAS has been making a number of website improvement projects, including creating webpages for each of the <a href="IACA Subcommittees">IACA Subcommittees</a> — many of which have gone live in September. We encourage the IACA subcommittees to continue to utilize these pages to share relevant resources and information regarding the apprenticeship community around the subcommittee. In addition, DAS is working on projects to both improve the apprenticeship lookup tool and also an improved apprenticeship standards dashboard to provide better insight into the registration process. Be on the lookout for gathering information about your program, in particular for the apprenticeship lookup tool, which DAS aims to make more user friendly and comprehensive of all registered apprenticeship programs in the state. In July, DAS launched a new building trades apprentice graduate lookup tool as mandated in Senate Bill 1162, which aims to help public works contractors comply with skilled and trained worker requirements.

# **Funding Information**

In October, the Round 3 recipients of the Apprenticeship Innovation Funding will be announced, with a total of \$29,852,345 in funds awarded and distributed in 2025 to reimburse the costs of supporting and training apprentices served in 2024.

August 1, 2025, DIR and DAS announced \$26 million in **Equal Representation in Construction Apprenticeship (ERiCA) grants** to 25 construction apprenticeship programs. This second round of funding expands efforts to increase women's participation and support disadvantaged communities in the construction trades. Funding priorities included:

- \$11.8 million for childcare to support pre-apprentices and apprentices.
- \$7.2 million for targeted recruitment to advance gender representation.
- \$7 million for worksite culture improvements, including mentoring, mental health, and anti-harassment training.

This round follows \$25 million awarded in Round 1 and continues the state's investment in equitable workforce development aligned with Governor Newsom's apprenticeship expansion goals.

September 2025, DAS officially opened the updated application process for \$20 million in the **California Apprenticeship Council (CAC) Training Funds**. The fund provides dedicated support to construction apprenticeship programs through formula funding grants that address training of construction apprentices and reimburses costs incurred in the previous fiscal year. The launch reflects CAC's commitment to strengthening California's skilled workforce pipeline and aligns with statewide workforce development and equity goals.

Both the CA Opportunity Youth Apprenticeship (COYA) Round 2 grantees and the ERiCA Round 2 grantees are all fully contracted and have kicked off grant activities. The Funding team has also been busy in updating the participant reporting system to better integrate with the CA Apprenticeship System (CAS) and the web registration system already used by all apprenticeship and pre-apprenticeship programs. The objective is to both ease the participant reporting process and to ensure eligibility of the participants served.

### Statistics of September 30 2025, this Committee / California total

The active apprentices numbered 21,138/91,950

New registrations and reinstatements numbered **2,538/9,154** for the quarter.

Minorities represented **78.6%** / **72.9%** of all active apprentices.

Active women apprentices numbered **6,314/8,810**, which is **29.9**% / **9.58**% of all active apprentices.

There are currently **1,204/4,414 active veterans**, **192/483** which registered, and **165/282** completed in 2025.

#### Program Evaluations July 1 2025, through September 30, 2025

Since July 1, 2025, DAS opened six (6) program evaluations, and four (4) evaluations have been completed. Four (4) program evaluations are in progress and there are thirty-three (33) programs with corrective action needed (seven (7) opened in 2022, five (5) opened in 2023, four (4) opened in 2024, and seventeen (17) opened in 2025). DAS consultants are monitoring these programs to ensure their recommendations are completed.

DAS will continue to send new evaluation notification letters one year following the creation of a new program or substantial expansion of an existing program. To ensure high-quality apprenticeship administration, consultants will assist apprenticeship programs with correcting the deficiencies found in order to close their evaluations/reviews.
