**Mr. Rood stated that no schools can be approved because QUORUM WAS NOT MET.**

Had a regular meeting and went to the “Other” section of the agenda to discuss. Ms. Martinez read the Inactive schools: 119 – Wyotech, 131 Santa Rosa Jr. College, 141 Everest College/Corinthian Colleges, Inc., 153 Wyotech Fremont, but 166 Abram Friedman was inactive and now wants to be active again due to increase in school budget.

Christine Hall from WECA wanted clarification on “partial” school requirement to become “full” schools. Ms. Martinez responded that there are “partial” schools that have submitted their request to become ‘full” in the near future they have submitted additional courses for review and approval to the Chancellor’s Office. However, there are still some schools that want to remain partial schools.

Oscar Meier from LAUSD commented that there are students who want to register, but classes are not given at that time. Ms. Martinez responded that a letter from the school must be provided indicating that the course is not given until the following semester, and this letter must be attached to the ET application when ET is registering with the State.
