MS. RICHARDSON: Hello everyone. My name is Nicole Richardson. We're going to go ahead and start today's public hearing.

Just so you know, this hearing is being recorded. We're going on the record, and this matter is being recorded.

Thank you for taking the time to be with us here this morning. I'm the attorney for the Division of Workers'

Compensation, and before we begin today's public hearing, I want to inform everyone that once again this is being recorded and we do have two hearing reporters with us today.

This is or noticed conference call and Zoom public hearing for the Evidence-Based Update and Adoption to the Medical Treatment Utilization Schedule. The Division is proposing to make updates to the Medical Treatment Utilization Schedule as contained in Title 8, California Code of Regulations Sections 9792.23.2 and Section 9792.23.3, Section 9792.23.4, and Section 9792.24.5.

I'd like to take a moment to introduce the DWC staff members on today's call. We have Dr. Raymond Meister, the DWC Medical Director; Maureen Gray, the Division's Regulations

Coordinator; the hearing reporters today are Darlene Cervantes and Cynthia Lord.

The purpose of this hearing is to receive comments on the proposed amendments to the Shoulder Disorder Guideline,

Elbow Disorder Guideline, Hand, Wrist and Forearm Disorder Guideline, and Traumatic Brain Injury Guideline as set forth in Regulation Sections 9792.23.2, 9792.23.3, 9792.23.4, and Section 9792.24.5. We welcome any comments that you have today. Please note that we will not request, respond to or discuss anyone's comments, although we may ask for clarification or ask you to elaborate further on any points that you are presenting. All of your comments, both given verbally here today and those submitted in writing, will be considered in determining what revisions if any we make to the proposed regulations.

If you would like to speak during this hearing, please use the "raise-your-hand" function or send a chat to the host and panelist requesting to speak. If you're calling in for this meeting, which I don't believe we have any call-in users but I could be wrong so I'll say it anyways, if you're calling in and you would like to speak, please press star nine and when your phone number is called, you will press star six to unmute yourself. Please restrict the subject of your comments to the proposed regulations. We ask that you limit your comments to five minutes. You will receive a message asking you to unmute yourself prior to your name being called. You must click the unmute message in order to speak. Please wait to speak until you are called upon. Your time will begin after you are unmuted and you are called upon. There will be a timer on the

screen to track your time. You will be muted after you have spoken for five minutes and the next person will be called.

We will call the names of those who have indicated they wish to speak today in the order received, and we apologize in advance if we mispronounce anyone's name. For the record, please begin by stating your name and any affiliation. All oral comments given today will be taken down by the hearing reporter. When everyone on the list has had a chance to make their public comments, I will check to see if anyone new has joined and wishes to speak or if anyone else has additional comments.

This hearing will continue for as long as people are on the line and wish to comment on the proposed regulations, but it will close at five o'clock this afternoon.
