**DETERMINATION AND ORDER
RE: SUSPENSION**

The Administrative Director of the Division of Workers' Compensation is required to suspend any physician, practitioner, or provider from participating in the California workers' compensation system as a physician, practitioner, or provider if the individual or entity meets any of the express criteria set forth in Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1).

Based upon a review of the record in the above-numbered combined cases, including the January 15, 2026 Determination and Order Re: Suspension issued in this action by Hearing Officer and Workers' Compensation Judge Jesus R. Perez, the Administrative Director finds that Respondents Ramirez Vocational Services, Inc., Ramirez & Associates, Inc., and CTS LP meet the criteria for suspension set forth in Labor Code section 139.21(a) and shall be suspended from participating in the California workers' compensation system as a physician, practitioner, or provider.
