**ORDER OF SUSPENSION**

WHEREAS, Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(A) requires the Administrative Director to suspend any physician, practitioner, or provider from participating in the workers' compensation system as a physician, practitioner, or provider if the individual has been convicted of any felony or misdemeanor described in Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(A); and

WHEREAS, on or about June 13, 2025, Respondent Jennifer Villegas aka Jenny V. Villegas pled guilty to or was found guilty of one or more felonies or misdemeanors described in Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(A) in the Los Angeles Superior Court of California; and

WHEREAS, on or about November 12, 2025, the Administrative Director mailed to Respondent Jennifer Villegas aka Jenny V. Villegas a written notice of the right to a hearing regarding the suspension and the procedure to follow to request a hearing, as provided in Labor Code section 139.21(b)(2) and California Code of Regulations, title 8, section 9788.1; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Labor Code section 139.21(b)(2) and California Code of Regulations, title 8, section 9788.1(d), the written notice advised Respondent Jennifer Villegas aka Jenny V. Villegas that the suspension would start thirty (30) calendar days after the date of mailing of written notice, unless Jennifer Villegas aka Jenny V. Villegas

1 submitted a written request for a hearing within ten (10) calendar days of the date of  
2 mailing of the notice; and

3 WHEREAS, Respondent Jennifer Villegas aka Jenny V. Villegas acknowledged the  
4 notice and filed a request for hearing within ten (10) calendar days of the date of mailing of  
5 the notice; and

6 WHEREAS, on January 22, 2026 a hearing was held before Workers Compensation  
7 Administrative Law Judge, Amy Britt; and

8 WHEREAS, on January 28, 2026 Judge Britt issued a Determination and Order Re:  
9 Suspension of Respondent Jennifer Villegas aka Jenny V. Villegas suspending her from  
10 participating in the workers' compensation system as a physician, practitioner, or provider;

11 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that Respondent Jennifer Villegas aka Jenny V. Villegas  
12 is hereby suspended from participating in the workers' compensation system as a  
13 physician, practitioner, or provider.
