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**PREDETERMINED INCREASES FOR
MODULAR FURNITURE INSTALLER (CARPENTER) CLASSIFICATIONS
(Determination NC-23-31-15-2012-1)**

IN ALAMEDA, ALPINE, AMADOR, BUTTE, CALAVERAS, COLUSA, CONTRA COSTA, DEL NORTE, EL DORADO, FRESNO, GLENN, HUMBOLDT, KINGS, LAKE, LASSEN, MADERA, MARIN, MARIPOSA, MENDOCINO, MERCED, MODOC, MONTEREY, NAPA, NEVADA, PLACER, PLUMAS, SACRAMENTO, SAN BENITO, SAN FRANCISCO, SAN JOAQUIN, SAN MATEO, SANTA CLARA, SANTA CRUZ, SHASTA, SIERRA, SISKIYOU, SOLANO, SONOMA, STANISLAUS, SUTTER, TEHAMA, TRINITY, TULARE, TUOLUMNE, YOLO AND YUBA COUNTIES

This predetermined increase for the above named craft applies only to the above-referenced determination for work being performed on public works projects with bid advertisement dates on or after **March 3, 2012** until this determination is superseded by a new determination or a predetermined increase modification notice becomes effective.

When referencing our prevailing wage determinations, please note that if the prevailing wage rate determination which was in effect on the bid advertisement date of a project, has a single asterisk (*) after the expiration date, the rate will be good for the life of the project. However, if a prevailing wage rate determination has double asterisks (**) after the expiration date, the rate must be updated on the following date to reflect the predetermined rate change(s).

MODULAR FURNITURE INSTALLER (All classifications)

Determination NC-23-31-15-2012-1 is currently in effect and expires on June 30, 2012**:

- **Effective July 1, 2012**, there will be a \$1.13 increase allocated as follows: \$0.50 to BHR, \$0.35 to H&W, \$0.10 to Pension, and \$0.18 to Vacation (\$0.03 to Work Fee).
- **Effective July 1, 2013**, there will be a \$1.16 increase allocated as follows: \$0.35 to Basic Hourly Rate, \$0.35 to Health & Welfare, \$0.13 to Pension, \$0.10 to Annuity, and \$0.23 to Vacation (\$0.03 to Work fee).
- **Effective July 1, 2014**, there will be a \$1.19 increase allocated as follows: \$0.40 to Basic Hourly Rate, \$0.35 to Health and Welfare, \$0.10 to Pension, \$0.06 to Annuity and \$0.28 to Vacation (\$0.03 to Work Fee).

There will be no further increases applicable to this determination.
