ELECTRICIAN: TRANSPORTATION SYSTEMS TECHNICIAN

The predetermined increase of \$1.00 effective on January 26, 2015, is incorrect. The correct amount of the predetermine increase is \$0.86. The increase was allocated as follows: \$0.41 to the Basic Hourly Rate, \$0.25 to Health & Welfare, and \$0.20 to Pension.

Future predetermined increases to be allocated to wages and/or fringe benefits have been modified as follows:

- The predetermined increase of \$1.05 on July 27, 2015, has been reduced to \$0.75, and \$0.05 to Other.
- The predetermined increase of \$1.00 on February 1, 2016, has been reduced to \$0.75.
- The predetermined increase of \$1.00 on August 1, 2016, has been reduced to \$0.75.
- The predetermined increase of \$1.00 on January 30, 2017, has been reduced to \$0.75.

With the exception of the above correction, all of the wage rates and other conditions found in the above referenced determination remain unchanged.
