**OPINION AND ORDER
DISMISSING PETITION
FOR REMOVAL**

On June 24, 2025, a workers' compensation administrative law judge (WCJ) issued an order continuing the trial of this matter to July 15, 2025.

On June 27, 2025, applicant filed a petition for removal contending that the continuance caused him significant prejudice and irreparable harm.

On July 15, 2025, the matter proceeded to trial.

More than five weeks have passed. Yet, we have not received notice from applicant's attorneys that the trial took place, and we have not received notice that the petition is withdrawn. This lack of action on applicant's part appears to contradict his premise that a delay of three weeks to commence trial caused him harm.

Accordingly, the petition for removal is now moot, and we will dismiss the petition.

For the foregoing reasons,

IT IS ORDERED that the Petition for Removal is **DISMISSED**.
