**OPINION AND ORDER
DISMISSING PETITION FOR REMOVAL**

Defendant has filed a petition for removal from the order of continuance issued on April 15, 2026, by the workers' compensation administrative law judge (WCJ).

Thereafter on July 13, 2026, defendant filed a petition to withdraw the petition for removal as the issue was moot.

We would admonish defense counsel, Andre Aladadyan (CA# 322015) of Bondy Law Group, that attorneys must proceed in good faith and may not present arguments, which could be construed as frivolous. (Lab. Code, 5813; Cal. Code. Regs., tit. 8, § 10421.) We would further admonish defense counsel that in workers' compensation, "Demurrers, petitions for judgment on the pleadings and petitions for summary judgment are not permitted." (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 8, § 10515.)

Accordingly, we will dismiss the petition for removal.

For the foregoing reasons,

IT IS ORDERED that the Petition for Removal from the order of continuance issued on April 15, 2026, by the WCJ is **DISMISSED**.
